Election Day – November 6th, 2018



Have you cast your vote for the upcoming elections? There are a lot of pivotal offices up for election this year: Governor, Lt. Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, and US Senator (6yr term)...just to name a few.

There are also proposed initiated laws on the ballot: **1.** To authorize and legalize possession, use and cultivation of marijuana products by individuals who are at least 21 years of age and older, and commercial sales of marijuana through state licensed retailers. **2.** A proposed constitutional amendment to establish a commission of citizens with exclusive authority to adopt district boundaries for the Michigan Senate, Michigan House of Representatives and U.S. Congress, every 10 years. **3.** A proposal to authorize automatic and Election Day voter registration, no-reason absentee voting, and straight ticket voting; and add current legal requirements for military and overseas voting and post-election audits to the Michigan Constitution
